

## NOUNS

A noun is a person, place, or thing. Additionally, a noun or a noun clause, when placed correctly, works as the subject of sentences.

### COMMON NOUNS

A common noun is any person, place, or thing.

EX:

chair  
computer  
window  
owl  
bark

### PROPER NOUNS

Proper nouns are more specific and/or significant persons, places, or things, which demand more emphasis. Therefore, they are usually capitalized.

EX:

Socialism  
Democracy  
United States of America  
Smithsonian Institute  
Fibonacci Numbers

### NOUN CLAUSE

A Noun Clause is a group of words containing a subject and a verb and which functions like a subject.

EX:

Letting off the gas saved our lives inevitably.

Working for the children's museum is a commendable yet stressful endeavor.
